How to dispose garbage at the Garbage Station

Please follow these rules and manners for taking out and sorting garbage

- Bring garbage on the set days.
- Bring garbage between dawn and 8:30 AM on garbage collection days.
- Bring garbage to garbage stations on the set days of your area.
- Please separate garbage into specified bags and tie the bags at the top.
- **Garbage stations are for household garbage only.**

When disposing of hazardous garbage


Hazardous garbage can cause fires in garbage trucks or cause injury to garbage collectors. Do not mix it with other types of garbage.



Disposal

1. Put in a designated garbage bag



Please remove rechargeable batteries (such as lithium and NiCad batteries) which can be removed.

2. Dispose at Garbage Station



If your garbage does not fit in the 45 L crushable garbage designated bag, tie it with a string or the like and bring it to a garbage station.

When disposing of broken glass, clearly label the contents and put it in a cardboard box.



2. Dispose at Garbage Station



Put the whole cardboard box into a bag if you dispose garbage in cardboard boxes on rainy days.



Items not collected at garbage stations

Waste Paper (Newspapers, fliers, magazines, mixed paper, cardboard, milk cartons, etc.)

Waste paper is a resource. Please do not dispose it as burnable garbage.

Disposal

1. Cross tie each type separately with string



1. Put mixed paper in paper bags or in magazines



Take off the clips

Or

1. Wash, open, and dry milk cartons before cross tying them



2. Bring to the designated locations

- Use local resource collection
- *Conducted by local residents' associations or PTAs
- Bring to a recycling station
- Bring to an environment center
- Bring to the Waste Paper Recycle Yard
- Bring to private waste paper collector sites



*You cannot dispose at Garbage Stations

Details of the disposal locations can be checked on an app to promote sorting garbage called "San aru"

Vehicle fire of garbage trucks can lead to a fatal accident for workers and local residents. We ask to properly separate and dispose garbage, and to cooperate in preventing fire accidents.



▲ Spray cans and rechargeable lithium-ion batteries which were in the crushable garbage and thought to be the cause of the fire.

Spray cans and gas lighters are hazardous garbage, and lithium-ion batteries go to shops nearby where recycles batteries.

Illegal dumping of garbage and taking resources are crimes

Illegal dumping of garbage

Randomly dumping away trash can result in a prison sentence of up to 5 years and a fine of up to ¥10,000,000 for individuals, or a prison sentence of up to 5 years and a fine of up to ¥300,000,000 for corporations.



Taking resources

Taking recyclable resources can result in a fine of up to ¥200,000.

*Resources: Cans, glass bottles, PET bottles, plastic containers and packaging, waste paper, cloths, electric appliances, metal products, and products containing metal.




