

カセットコンロの爆発事故に注意！ Beware of portable gas stove explosions!

Example incident

In July, 2020 in Toyohashi, an incident occurred when a portable gas stove was placed on top of a gas cooktop, and the canister exploded when the grill was lit.

The examples in the pictures below are extremely dangerous.

If a portable stove is misused, the canister can overheat, which can result in explosions and fires. Please take precautions and use portable stoves safely

● Do not use overly large pots and pans


● Do not store gas canisters in hot environments
(in a car in the summer, near a stove, etc.)



● Do not use for reasons other than preparing food



● Do not use with stone or ceramic cookware



● Do not use multiple portable stoves together

● Do not place on top of a gas cooktop

◇ Please dispose of gas canisters after emptying the contents entirely, and follow Toyohashi's rules for disposal.



After emptying the contents entirely, please dispose of gas canisters as "dangerous garbage" (危険ごみ *kiken gomi*)

You do not need to put a hole in the canister.

If gas canisters are not fully emptied, they can leak in the garbage truck or disposal facilities and cause fires or injuries to the cleaning crew.
